

instrument choices violin



• Relatively quiet!

 To play: use fingers to pluck (pizzicato) or use the bow.

Violin

Viola


Played like a violin

 Bigger than a violin, with a deeper, darker, more mellow sound



Cello

- Bigger instrument
- Lower sounding instrument
- It has to be played sitting down.
- Be aware that school buses may not allow cellos due to size.



 Largest and lowest-sounding of the string instruments

 You stand or sit on a stool to play.

Important Note: Not available for rent at the school. If a student wants to play double bass, he/she/they will need to rent from a local music store.

woodwind instrument choices




Flute

- The flute has the highest pitch of the wind instruments.
- The flute requires more practice in the beginning due to the embouchure (way you form your mouth to play).
- Small enough to put in backpacks!

Clarinet

- The clarinet is a reed instrument.
- Higher sounding instrument
- Easy to carry to school!
- More suitable for students with bigger pads to their fingers



Alto Saxophone

- Biggest of the woodwinds we offer
 - Reed instrument

 May be too heavy for some students to play at this age. The weight goes on the student's neck.

brass instrument choices

Trumpet



- Smallest brass instrument
- Highest-sounding brass instrument
- Mutes are available if needed to muffle the sound at home.

Trombone

- It has a slide!
- Trombone students should have longer arms to extend the slide.
 - Larger instrument



Baritone

- Very large, and heavy instrument!
- Should play while sitting.

 Sounds very similar to a trombone



AND LAST BUT NOT LEAST...

PERCUSSION!!

Percussion



- You will stand to play.
- As a beginner, you will learn 2 instruments at the same time (snare drum & xylophone). You will also get a glimpse of other percussive instruments.
- Best suited for a student with great music literacy skills
- Is the metronome (timekeeper) of the band
