


HOW TO PREPARE FOR A SUCCESSFUL YEAR


 Set a healthy routine - 10-12 hours of sleep, nutritious breakfast

 Mornings and evenings - enough time to get ready, reading before bed Talk positively with your child about the first day of school - they will be welcomed and supported


 Acknowledge that your child may have a variety of feelings about school






















WAYS TO STAY CONNECTED

REGISTERING FOR KINDERGARTEN

Registration for kindergarten is open!

Children whose 5th birthday is on or before Sept 30th may register for kindergarten

There is no deadline for registering, but sooner is better

All registration and health requirements must be met before a child is admitted to school
